
RMRP 2025-26 Gender Mainstreaming: Gender marker with age GAM



Deadline for submission: September 5-22



Key elements GAM:

- 1 A tool designed by the Inter-Agency Humanitarian Coordination Committee (IASC) that promotes an <u>effective</u>, <u>equitable</u> and <u>participatory response</u> based on the identification of the needs and capacities of any population in terms of <u>gender</u>, <u>age and disability</u>.
- 2 Responds to the principles established in different international frameworks on the inclusion of the intersectional gender approach in the response to the refugee and/or migrant population.
- **3** This <u>online questionnaire</u> <u>identifies the degree to which the gender approach is included</u> by giving a score between 0 and 4, as well as a reference code (e.g. G855221724). Each organization/agency should make an MGE for the RMRP, taking the set of activities it proposes to implement in 2025 and 2026 as if they were a single project.



Guidance note / inclusion of the gender approach in the needs assessment: key points

"We will ensure that our responses to large movements of refugees and migrants incorporate a gender perspective, promote gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls, and fully respect and protect the human rights of women and girls." New York Declaration for Refugees and Migrants (2016).

- Integrating a gender approach ensures that the needs, differences and human rights of women, girls, boys and men in their diversity will be **understood and addressed**.
- ➤ Gathering available information that is supported by data disaggregated by gender and age makes it possible to elaborate **gender contexts**.
- Recognizing the importance of **participatory processes** involving men and women throughout the project cycle accelerates the closing of gender gaps.
- > Promoting the inclusion of a gender approach implies having indicators, objectives and specific activities.

Preparation prior to filling out the MGE/GAM

4 key questions - levels within the design of the activities:

- Gender analysis: What information and/or data were taken into account for the design of the activities of this submission? Does it have needs assessments that incorporate these approaches? Does it include LGBTIQ+ people? Does it include a disability approach? specific data and reports.
- **Tailor-made activities:** How is this differential approach incorporated in the proposed actions? How will assistance be adapted to the different groups?
- Participation: How do the beneficiary populations participate in the activities and does it take into account the participation of all groups by gender and age?
- Benefits: Do we have indicators that allow us to identify whether we are meeting the needs with this differential approach?

GAM codes

- 4 the actions are intended to contribute to gender equality in all age groups and/or people with disabilities;
- **3** the actions are intended to contribute to gender equality, but without paying attention to age groups and/or people with disabilities;
- 2 actions attempt to address age and/or disability differences, but without attention to gender equality;
- 1 the actions do not respond to gender, age or disability differences; nor do they address the different needs of specific groups of interest; and
- 0 the proposal does not integrate actions.

Descripción

Además de responder a los principios establecidos en diferentes marcos internacionales como la Declaración de Nueva York para los Refugiados y los Migrantes (2016) o el Pacto mundial para la migración segura, ordenada y regular (2018), es un instrumento estandarizado que permite crear mejores proyectos y desarrollar capacidades para la incorporación del enfoque de género, incluyendo edad (ciclo vital) y discapacidad. También es la única fuente cuantitativa de datos globales sobre estos aspectos que permite al RMRP contar con un reporte general sobre sus avances al respecto. El MGE alienta a los equipos de planificación, implementación y monitoreo de planes y proyectos a reflexionar sobre las necesidades específicas de la población en función de su género, edad y/o discapacidad, así como a identificar si la asistencia propuesta es relevante, sensible y está adaptada a las necesidades y prioridades de todos los grupos de la población.
